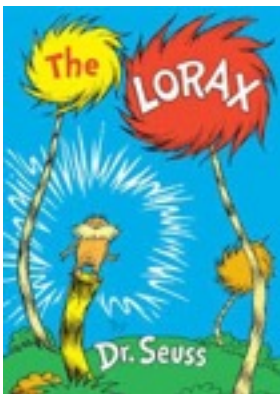

The 2013 award winning documentary *Facing Fear* is the story of the reconciliation of a former neo-Nazi skinhead and the gay victim of his hate crime who meet by chance 25 years later. Running time 23 minutes. A discussion about repentance and forgiveness will follow. Recommended for adults and older children.



Based on the Dr Seuss book, this made for TV version of *The Lorax* (1972) chronicles the plight of the Lorax, the lone voice of the Tuffula trees which are in danger of extinction due to a greedy factory owner. Running time is 23 minutes. A discussion about environmental awareness and preserving our natural resources will follow. Recommended for children of all ages.

* Selichot are the special prayers that are traditionally recited the Shabbat before the High Holidays. It is traditional to engage in some form of study as well.
